How many documents do I need to produce? 3 documents (one must be from Group 1 and any two from either group 1 or group 2). If you cannot provide any document from group 1 you will need to provide 3 documents (one from group 2a and 2 further documents from Group 2a or 2b one of which much verify your current address). There is a further route which would need to be discussed if necessary as a last resort.

Group 1. (primary trusted identity credentials)

- Current valid Passport (If not in current name i.e. maiden name we will need original UK marriage certificate/deed poll certificate to support name change)
- Biometric Resident Permit (UK)
- UK Driving Licence (full or provisional) Isle of Mann/Channel Islands; photo card ID version only
- UK & Channel Islands Birth Certificate issued within 12 months of birth full or short form including those issued by UK authorities overseas, such as embassies, high commissions and HM Forces.
